### 1. Event details:

Class Flags must be displayed on all yachts competing in Classes J, E, U, O, G, B and C

### 5. Time Limit

No boat will be timed in after 17.00hrs. In classes where more than one round is scheduled and no boat in the class completes the course within the time limit, the Race Officer may, at his/her discretion, declare a result based upon times taken at the end of the first round. RRS 35 will not apply.

### 6. Prize Giving (including prizes for Fancy Dress)

At the Club as soon as possible after sailing, where competitors will be very welcome and refreshments and music will be provided.. The bar will be open from 15.00hrs.
