

FALMOUTH TYRES FLUSHING /FOWEY / FLUSHING RALLY 2011.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- Event Details : Weekend rally Flushing / Fowey / Flushing, organised by Flushing Sailing Club and sponsored by Falmouth Tyres, will be held on Saturday 18th and Sunday 19th June 2011 in accordance with the following instructions. The results will be an aggregate of both races unless the Committee make other decisions based on weather conditions over the two days.
- Classes : The classes competing will be:
 - Class Q - I.R.C. rated Yachts
 - Class E - PY rated Yachts 1063 & below
 - Class U - PY rated Yachts 1064 & above

CLASS FLAGS TO BE FLOWN

- Rules : The races will be run under the current Racing Rules of Sailing, class rules as applicable, the Flushing Sailing Club Sailing Instructions and Notice of Race and RYA prescriptions except as modified herein.
- Start Times : Start times for Saturday off Flushing Clubhouse Quay will be:
 - Warning signal : 10.20 Q Class
 - Preparatory Signal : 10.25 Q Class and E & U Warning Signal
 - Start 10.30 Q Class and Preparatory for E & U Classes
 - Start 10.35 E & U Class
- Time Limit : There is no time limit but Skippers should ensure notification if retirement from race.
- Start Line : Flushing Start Line will be as FSC Sailing Instructions 2011.

The Start Line in Fowey will be a line through a pair of transit marks positioned on the Western headland outside the entrance to Fowey Harbour.

Radio transmissions will be on Channel 72

FINISHING Will BE ON BOTH CLUB LINES

CANNIS and GWINEAS BUOYS MUST BE LEFT TO SEAWARD

YACHTS who have not already entered, must fill in the registration form together with a fee of £7 each race and include an I.R.C. rating certificate if applicable. These should be sent to the Treasurer.

SAFETY: See FSC Notice of RACE.

Crew list for each yacht should be sent in and Coastguard notified.

Yachts should keep a listening watch on Channel 72
