

# 2009 FALMOUTH TYRES Flushing/Fowey/Flushing RALLY

## SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.

**1. Event details:** Weekend rally Flushing/Fowey/Flushing, organised by Flushing Sailing Club and sponsored by Falmouth Tyres, will be held on Saturday 6th & Sunday 7th June 2009 in accordance with the following instructions. The results will be an aggregate of both races unless the committee make other decisions based on weather conditions on the two days.

**2. Classes:** The classes competing will be:  
class A, I.R.C. rated Yachts  
class J J24's  
class E Portsmouth Yardstick rated Yachts 1063 & below  
class U Portsmouth Yardstick rated Yachts 1064 & above.  
Class flags to be flown.

**3. Rules:** The races will be sailed under the current Racing Rules of Sailing, class rules as applicable, the Flushing Sailing Club Sailing Instructions and Notice of Race and RYA prescriptions except as modified herein.

**4. Start times:** Start times for **Saturday** off Flushing Clubhouse Quay will be:

Warning signal	10.25 hours
A class & J class	10.30 hours
E class & U class	10.35 hours

Start times for **Sunday** off Fowey will be:

Warning signal	10.25 hours
All classes	10.30 hours

**5. Time limit.** There is no specified time limit for either day but Skippers must ensure notification of arrival or retirement from racing (see safety requirements).

**6. Start line:** The start line in Flushing will be as FSC Sailing Instructions 2009 .  
The start line in Fowey will be a line through a pair of transit marks positioned on the Western headland outside the entrance to Fowey harbour. A boat flying a red flag will give starting signals

**7. Starting signals:** Starting signals will be given in accordance with FSC 2009 Sailing Instructions at 5 minute intervals. Radio transmissions will be on Channel 72 if possible.

### **8. Finishing line:**

Fowey The finishing line will be between transits above R.F.Y.C. clubhouse with a large silver painted buoy to be used as an outer distance mark. Finishing sound signals will not necessarily be given

## **9. Courses:**

Flushing/Fowey

`A` & `J` classes FSC start line- RFYC finish line leaving

Gwineas & Cannis Buoys to Port

`E` & `U` classes FSC start line to RFYC finish line leaving Gwineas & Cannis Buoys to Port

Fowey / Flushing

All classes RFYC start line to FSC finish line leaving Cannis &

Gwineas Buoys to starboard

**10. Race entry details.** Yachts which have not already entered a FSC race registration form may send the FSC Race Registration Form together with a fee of £7.00 each race and I.R.C. rating certificate if applicable, to the Treasurer.

**11 Finishing** All competitors must record their finishing times, note the boat ahead and astern and make a declaration of these to the Vice Commodore Charles Choak or Commodore Harold Martin no later than 22.00 hours the following Tuesday.

**12. Safety** See FSC Notice of Race 2009 particularly with regard to notification of telephone contact with crew list for each day

Saturday 6th June Flushing - Fowey Skippers should ensure that they have notified HM Coastguard and have a current CG66 and that a responsible person ashore has the details of all next of kin

Sunday 7th Fowey – Flushing. Any competitor proposing not to race must ensure that they notify the FSC clubhouse, if they retire and that the arrival of their yacht has been recorded, use clubhouse telephone, mobile or VHF this must be by 18.30 hours.

All yachts should keep a listening watch on channel 72, and use this channel for communication during the race.

Please see Notice of Race for all safety details.
