NOTES

The start for the first Class will be the Preparatory Gun for the second class and so on. Three boats to start or no & 6, five or more entries of one class will be judged separately. The Committee may make any necessary programme alterations and shall have the final decision in all disputes. Protest flags must be flown. Notice of protest must be given to the Race Officer within one hour of the finish of the last race.

PRIZES

Prizes will be presented for the first three in each Class.

Prizes for Working Boats will be: £20, £15, £10.

All Prizes and Trophies (where appropriate) are to be collected from the Quay or within 7 days from Trevor Pooley, Jewyan, Chycoose Farm, Point.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

COURSES

Boats will sail on one of the courses detailed below.

Course numbers will be displayed at the preparatory Gun of each race.

- Start Line**, No.1 Mark (Green or Black), No.2 Mark (Green or Black), through the Finishing Line, No.3 Mark (Green or Black) leaving **Green or Black** marks to **PORT**. Three Complete Rounds plus No.1 Mark (Green or Black), No.2 Mark (Green or Black) Then through Finishing Line to Finish.
- Start Line**, No.1 Mark (black) (**PORT**), Messack, (**PORT**), Pill (**PORT**), No.2 Mark (black) (**PORT**), No.3 Mark (Black) to (**PORT**) then through Finish Line to Finish.

NOTES

Red flags in Restronguet Creek denote shallow water. Shortened course(s) will be displayed if necessary.

START LINE

The **Start Line** is between a **Floating Buoy** (white) and a **White Outer Distance Mark** and is an extension of the **White Transit Poles** on Point Quay. Triangle in Front. At the start Point Quay is left to **PORT**.

FINISHING LINE

The **Finishing Line** is between the **Floating Buoy** (white) and the **White Transit Pole** on Point Quay, triangle in front. **POINT QUAY** left to **STARBOARD**.

RECALL

If a boat is over the Start Line at the Start, a second horn will be sounded. If a boat fails to return, it will be disqualified. The P.A. System may be used to inform the boat that it is over the line.

ALTERNATIVE PENALTY (All Classes)

Rules 44.1 & 44.2 are amended to allow infringements to perform a 360° turn instead of a 720° turn.

TIME

No boat will be timed in after 8.00 pm.
